

YOWGURRABAH INDEMNITY / LIABILITY WAIVER

Signing this form indicates that you and all members associated with your group/party agree to accept all responsibility for accidents, incidents and injuries involving your group or members of your group, while you are on or as the result of having been on Yowgurrabah. You and the members of your group are agreeing that *no litigation* will be initiated by or on behalf of any person associated with or representing the group/party against Numinbah Valley Adventure Trails, the property owner(s) or Synergy Applied Adventure Pty Ltd and their associates with regard to accidents, injuries or incidents.

Further, by signing this form you are indicating that you and the members of your group/party, accept that Numinbah Valley Adventure Trails, the property owner(s) and Synergy Applied Adventure Pty Ltd and their associates have the right to take whatever steps they deem necessary, to protect their interests and to recover costs incurred as the result of incidents involving your group. Numinbah Valley Adventure Trails, The property owner(s) and Synergy Applied Adventures Pty Ltd and their associates reserve the right to revoke access permission at any time.

1. No fires without permission. Even then keep fires small. NO BONFIRES!
(do not cut down or burn standing timber or logs used for seating)
2. Keep noise levels down after 10.00pm and before 7.00am
3. NO ROCKS AROUND FIRE PITS, dig a pit and then fill back up when leaving.
4. Leave campsite areas as you found them, clean and tidy.
5. Remember TRAIL RIDES HAVE RIGHT OF WAY.
6. NO GLASS IS TO BE ON PROPERTY OR PUT IN FIREPITS
7. ABSOLUTELY NO ACCESS IS ALLOWED TO ANY HOUSING IN OR AROUND CAMPSITES
8. Supervise children and adolescents especially if bushwalking or swimming.
9. Do not dig trenches other than for fire pits.
10. Accept directions from representatives of the Numinbah Valley Adventure Trails, Lyons Family or Synergy.
11. Avoid polluting the creek with detergent or toilet effluent. Ie, please no soap or shampoo in the river system.
12. Keep vehicle movement to an absolute minimum and leave all gates as you found them. Access gates are to remain locked.
13. No vehicles are to cross the creek unless authorised.
14. Caravan/campervan toilets are not to be emptied into any of NVAT toilets. Anyone caught doing so will be charged a \$60 cleaning fee.
15. Please report all damage and incidents involving injury to Management.
16. Respect cattle and horses on the property. Trail rides pass the campsites and waterholes. Please NO sudden noise or movements till they are well clear.
17. Dogs are allowed but need to be restrained of an evening due to wild dog activities.
18. Dogs must not chase cattle, horses or any wildlife.
19. Do not exceed the permission granted to you.
20. No firearms permitted.
21. If campsite is left untidy, a cleaning fee will be charged to you. No exceptions!
22. All rubbish is to be removed and for your convenience rubbish skips are located 500m passed Numinbah Valley hall on the right heading to Nerang.
23. No diving off the rocks.
24. Fishing is catch and release only.
25. No prohibited or illicit drugs are to be brought onto the property. Alcohol consumption within moderation.
26. No Swimming equipment is to be left at the waterholes, i.e.: Inflatable toys, boogie boards etc.
27. Day visitors MUST report to reception prior to heading to the campground. Each day visitor will need to pay \$5 to receive a wristband and the gate code.
